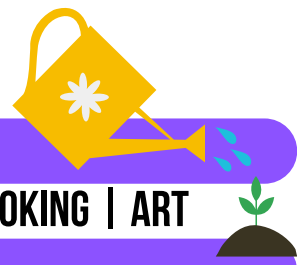

Animals | Art Farm animal educators will bring live animals to the classrooms for an animal science lesson. Children will enjoy close-up encounters with friendly live animals as they learn about habitats, behaviors, and care.

Art | Children can look forward to creative, sensory-rich projects that encourage imagination, build fine motor skills, and let them experiment freely with color, texture, and a variety of art materials.

Science | Boost your child's curiosity with Mad Science workshops for campers entering grades 1–4, featuring a lively mix of fun experiments, interactive learning, and exciting science-themed entertainment.

Cooking | During cooking, children will engage in simple, interactive cooking activities where they mix, measure, taste, and learn about ingredients while building confidence in the kitchen. All cooking will be sent home with your child with its ingredient list and recipe.

Lunch | Families can choose to bring in a nut-free lunch from home or buy a lunch from us for \$8/day. Snack will be provided by The Art Farm.

Music | Children will explore rhythm, movement, and melody through joyful musical activities that encourage listening skills, exploration, and self-expression while using a variety of kid-friendly instruments.

Sports & Active Play | Utilizing Trevor Day School's gymnasium, children will enjoy energetic games and active play that build gross motor skills, cooperation, and confidence while keeping them moving and having fun. Campers will also visit the Asphalt Green Playground and Rupert Park.

Terrace Gardening & Play | On our camp floor terrace, children will discover the joys of gardening and outdoor terrace games, learning about plants, nature, and teamwork while enjoying fresh air and playful exploration with bubbles and sidewalk chalk.

Swimming | Kids will splash into swimming fun twice a week at the 92Y! Children enrolled five days a week enjoy two swim sessions, while those attending two or three days get one. Led by Red Cross-trained instructors, each child's skills are assessed on the first day so everyone—from beginner to pro—can dive in safely and confidently.

Electives | Children will choose from a variety of fun electives led by their teachers, exploring new skills and interests while expressing themselves and trying something new!
